- Increase consultation opportunities between the administration and the council

2024/2025 ACHIEVEMENTS

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Started the year with establishing a mission and vision for the council
- Had a council brainstorming session dedicated to determining goals and objectives for the year based on feedback from previous years
- Identified subcommittees required to achieve our goals and objectives
 - 1. Fundraising/Bursary/PROGrant
 - 2. Staff and student wellness
 - 3. Bylaws and governance
 - 4. Student experiences
- Recruited council members for participation on each subcommittee enabling parents and caregivers to participate in ways that were meaningful to them

ENGAGEMENT

Parent, Caregiver & Community Engagement

- Increased and consistent attendance at council meetings from previous years
- Supported the request for both in person and hybrid meetings
- Sub-committees created to enable parents and caregivers to contribute to areas
 that are of value to them
- Fundraising activities that reached all parents and caregivers even if not on council, to contribute to the school community
- Engaged with local business to support fundraising efforts and get Dunbarton school community members into their establishments
- Created an SCC Instagram page for communication with the Dunbarton Community

FUNDRAISING

- Incredible efforts with fundraising to work toward raising the funds to put a new sound system into the gym
- 6 different fundraising opportunities successfully completed:
 - School Cash Online donations for Leaf Ticket Raffle
 - Swiss Chalet Dunbarton Night
 - Burger's Priest Dunbarton Night
 - Domino's Pizza Dunbarton Night
 - Papa John's Pizza Dunbarton Night
 - COBBS Bread Dunbarton Day

\$3,000+

PROGRANT

- Proposal submitted for \$5,000 grant toward hosting a parent and caregiver wellness night
- Committee came back with more questions
- Didn't get approval until early May, for \$1,500
- Made the decision that the amount and the time delay in approval, would not enable successful completion of the event
- Feedback sent to the committee on barriers to use: a) amount; b) late response
- NEXT YEAR ©!!!

STUDENT BURSARY

- Student bursary for \$500 created for a graduating student
- Criteria: Good academic standing, demonstrated leadership in the school and outside of the school community and evidence of ongoing commitment to leadership
- Executive reviewed the applications (350-500 word application on how they demonstrate the criteria)
- Recipient selected and will be awarded the bursary at graduation

SUBCOMMITTEE WORK

Bylaws and Governance

BYLAWS

First set of Bylaws created to engange and guide the School Community Council governance, reviewed by council and approved

CONSULTATION

- School administration has brought items to the council for consultation and feedback
- The DDSB Board Chair, Vice Chair and Trustee attended one of the council meetings to hear what is happening at Dunbarton and get feedback on what they could be doing at the board level to support the school
- Leadership qualities survey brought to council for feedback on what Dunbarton needs in a future adminsitrator

SUBCOMMITTEE UPDATES

Staff and Student Wellness

STUDENT WELLNESS

- Pilot project through the school to implement hall "monitor" presence teacher representative engaged with the union for support
- Volunteer teachers participated in addition to school administrators
- Successful pilot in reducing students in the hallway, vandalism and bathroom misuse
- Teachers and administrators performing this function takes them away from other essential work and is not a sustainable model
- Committee developed a proposal for the DDSB to consider funding a future CYW to support this initiative
