Before the Ceremony

- Eat a hearty and nutritious breakfast/lunch as you will not be able to eat again until after 3:00 pm (Consider bringing a bottle of water and a small snack.)
- Dress in businesslike attire
 - Dress pants and shirts, ties, blouses, dresses, skirts
- Arrive promptly at 11:15 a.m. Wednesday, June 28th
 - You will need time to find parking and orient yourself.
 - Don't forget free parking is available in 'Founders Lot 2' and 'Commencement South Lot'.
 - Allow yourself 10 minutes to walk to the building from the parking lot.

- Upon arrival at Durham College/Ontario Tech, report immediately to the Gowning Room, to the left of the main entrance, in the Campus Recreation and Wellness Center.
- Once you arrive in the Gowning Room,
 - Pick up your Name Card from your assigned table. (Tables will be arranged in alpha order by last name.)
 - Pick up and put on your cap and gown.
 - Line up in numerical order as directed. (You may NOT leave this area until marshalled into the auditorium.)

After the Ceremony

 Following the ceremony, graduation packages will be available at tables at the back of the auditorium. (Graduates must pick-up their graduation package personally - Packages will NOT be given to family members / friends.)

**Information regarding how to access your grad picture will be in your graduation package.

- **During the Ceremony**
- Remain in your seat during the entire ceremony.
 - Maintain a quiet, attentive and respectful environment
- You will be signaled to approach the stage.
 - At the side of the stage, hand your card to the teacher reading names.
 - When you hear your name, cross the stage and shake hands with the presenter as per your comfort level.
 - Pause briefly for your picture** and look towards the photographer
 - \circ $\;$ Exit the stage at the opposite side.
 - Return to your seat DO NOT cross in front of the stage. (Teachers will be directing you.)
