<p><b>Teacher's Report</b> <b>Jim Blair absent</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Grade 12 Gala is June 8, 2026. The students will receive a presentation on appropriate behavior and highlights this event as a privilege. Gala committee are working on plans for this special eveing.</li> <li>- Exams have been scheduled for June 15-18 for grade 12's. Grade 9-11 will write exams june 17-21.</li> <li>- Approximately 400 students are graduating.</li> <li>- Students participated in Fire Drills this week and Health and Safety reviews will take place by the end of the year to identify repair needs etc.</li> <li>- Lockdown drills have already taken place this year. Blue lights are also located outside to ensure outside classrooms know of any lockdowns or hold and secures drills.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Student's Report</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Alisha president reported on the Spirit Week, and the spring event called the Spartun Spring Bunny. Both successful events</li> <li>- Super Sparten Day is on June 26<sup>th</sup> regardless of the weather. Vendors will be present. Clubs, councils will run events as well as inflatable attractions – such as a baseket ball game. Therapy dogs will also be present. Food will be on sale for a minimal price. Thought and planning went into this with the goal of having all students stay to participate.</li> <li>- Parent Volunteers are required over the lunch period to hand out food.
